Building narratives on migration and integration in Athens

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- Following the outbreak of the refugee crisis in the summer of 2015, the City of Athens has found itself in the forefront of an unprecedented crisis for both Greece and Europe.
- Athens became the biggest European city of transit and has seen the greatest influx of refugees. Extreme pressure ever since to provide fast and practical solutions.

The need: to improve the response of the City to the complex needs of migrants & refugees





Visibility of 'the other'


'In your neighbourhood are there people of other nationalities (religion)'?






Attitudes towards co-existence with refugees

66% of respondents stated that the presence of refugees in their neighbourhood has not created a problem (32% said it did).







B.'In your opinion is it better that refugees live in special camps only for refugees or in rental apartments?'




C. Attending public schools & municipal kindergartens

Athens: A low-profile, albeit proactive approach

- Overall, Athens pioneered a paradigm shift for local authorities in Greece
 - However, the City kept a low profile from a communications perspective
- Many ad hoc initiatives to reach out, raise awareness, inform and bring together migrant & refugee communities with Athenians
 - **ESTIA** (ADDMA, UNHCR) : Human Library Listen to my story
 - ACCMR:The Bahar project
 - Athens Open Schools
 - More recently: Curing the Limbo pilot programme

Thoughts on current narratives

- After almost four years...
 - Human tragedy narrative 'fatigue'
 - Success story 'fatigue'
- Failure to 'speak' to/engage with a wider audience
 - Often a problematic dichotomy when building narratives: US (the good guys) vs THEM (the bad guys)
 - Need of human interest, evidence-based narrative, with accessible content
- Engagement with migrant communities on narrative development

In the absence of political will and positive narratives on migration at the national level of government, combined with the absence of concrete national reception & integration systems, local governments have – to an extent – their hands tied.
