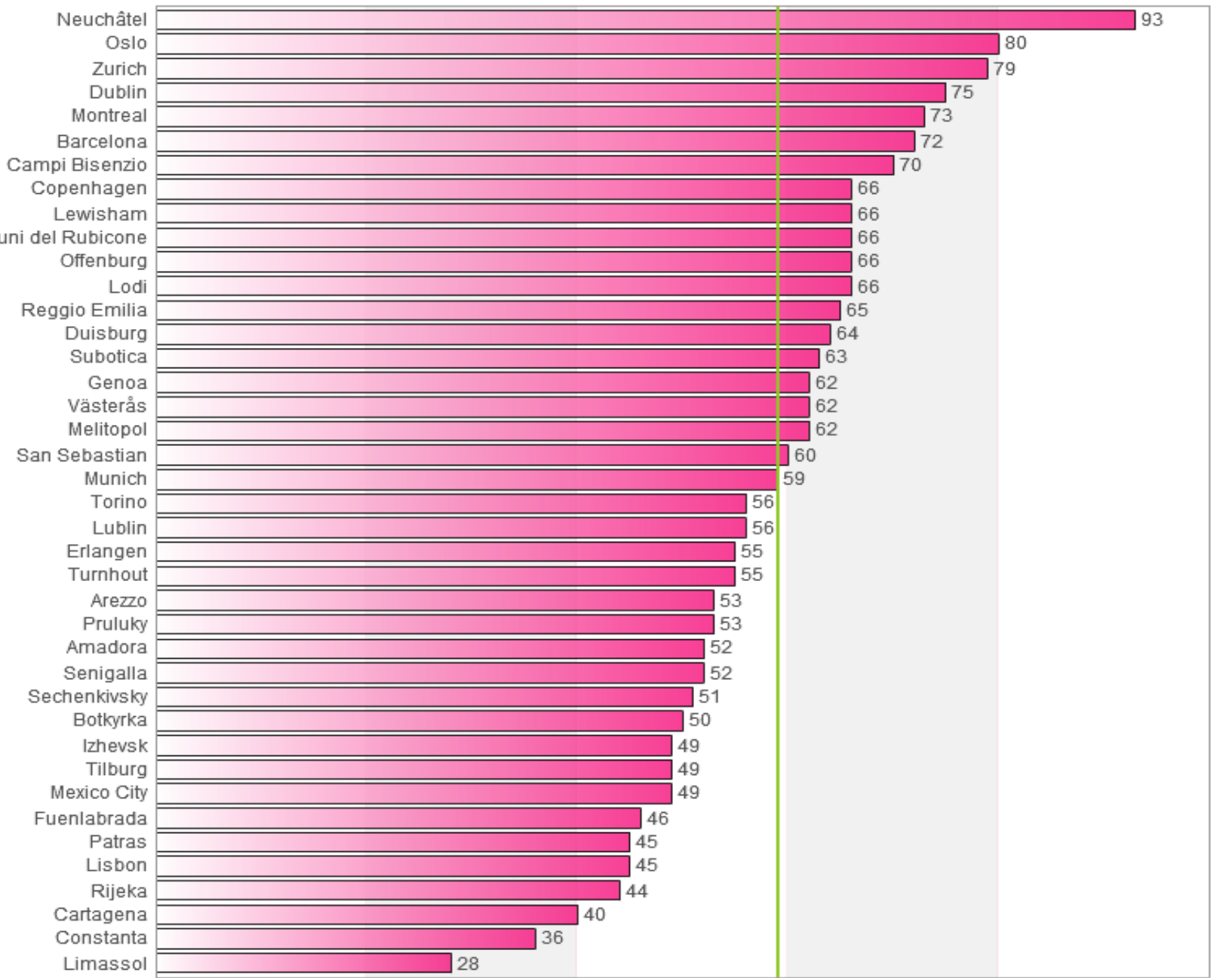

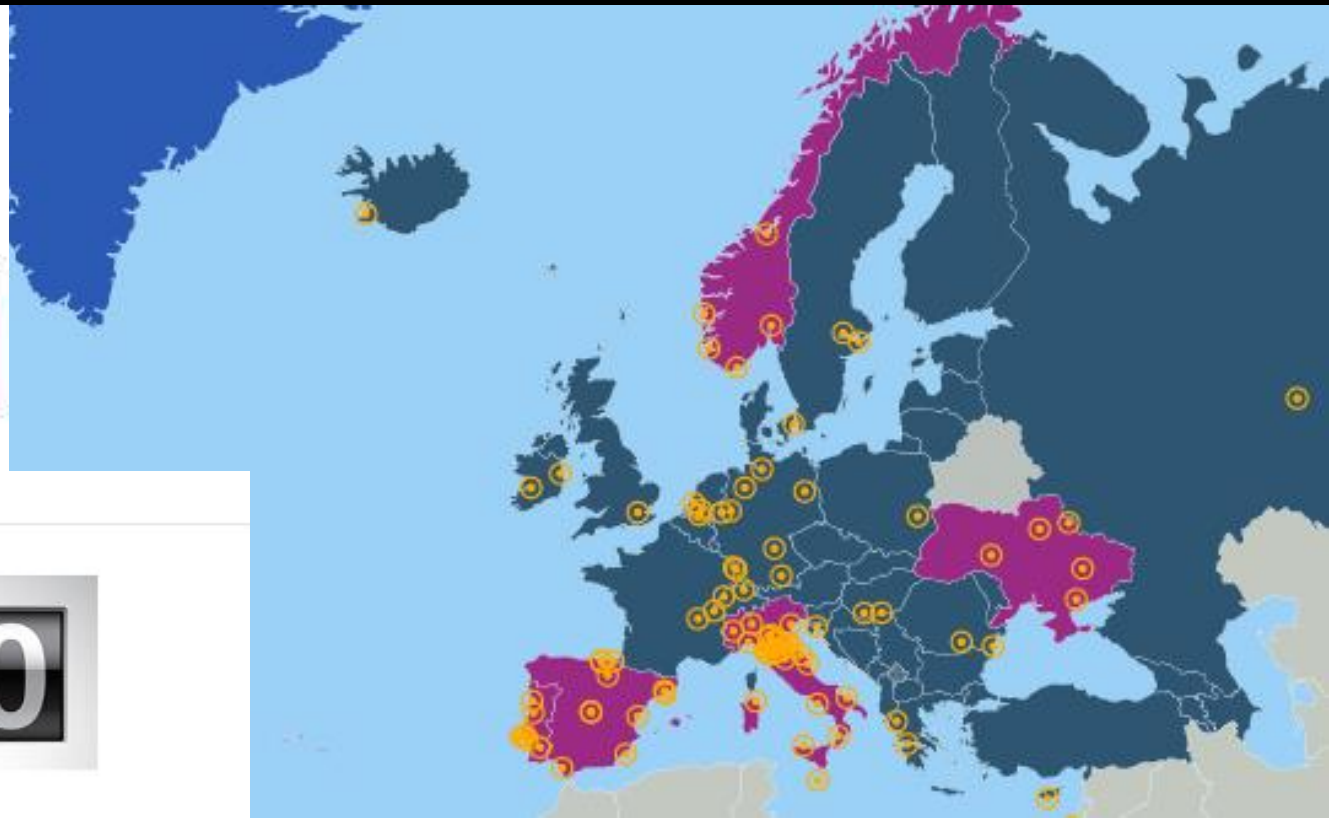

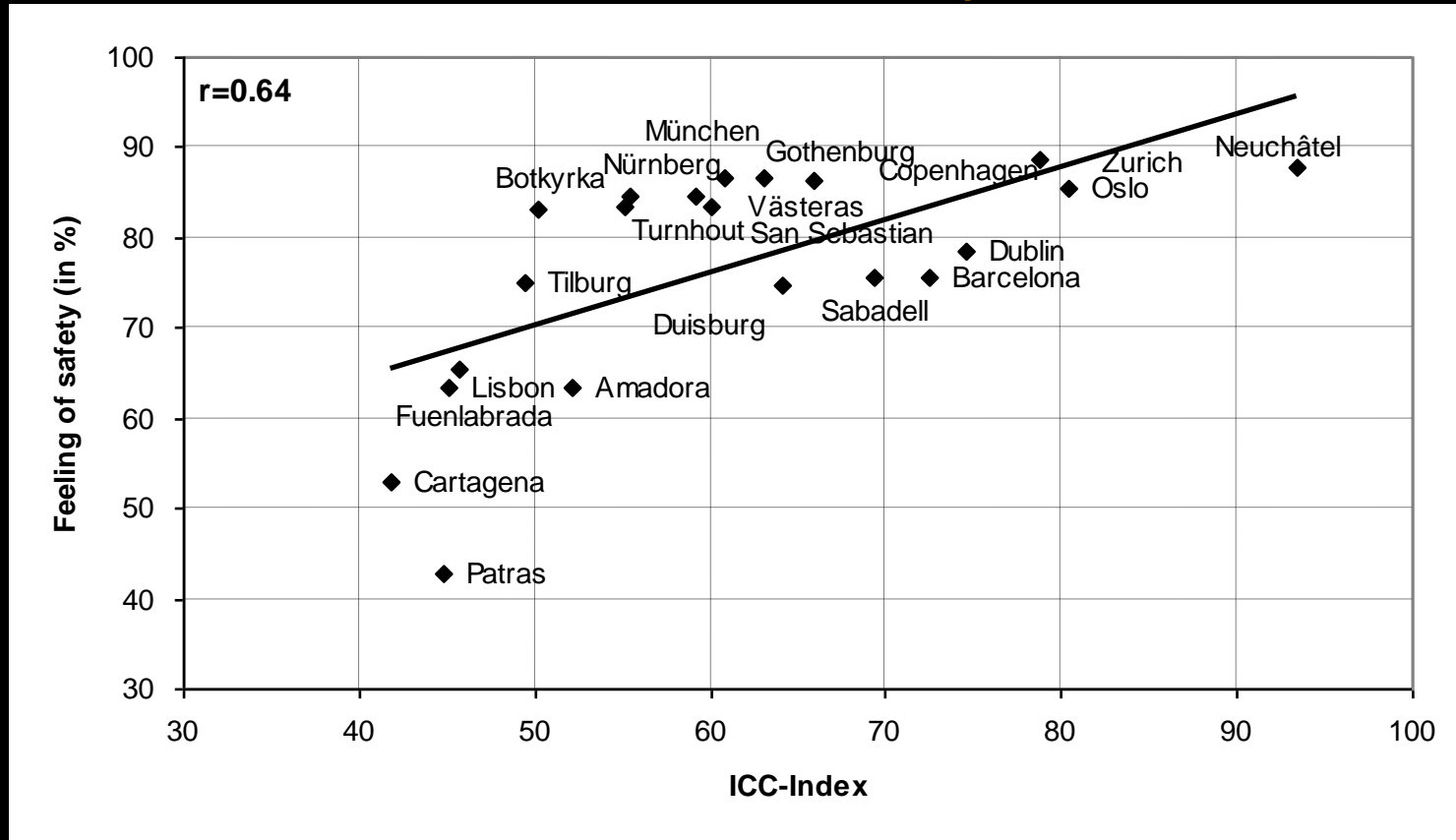

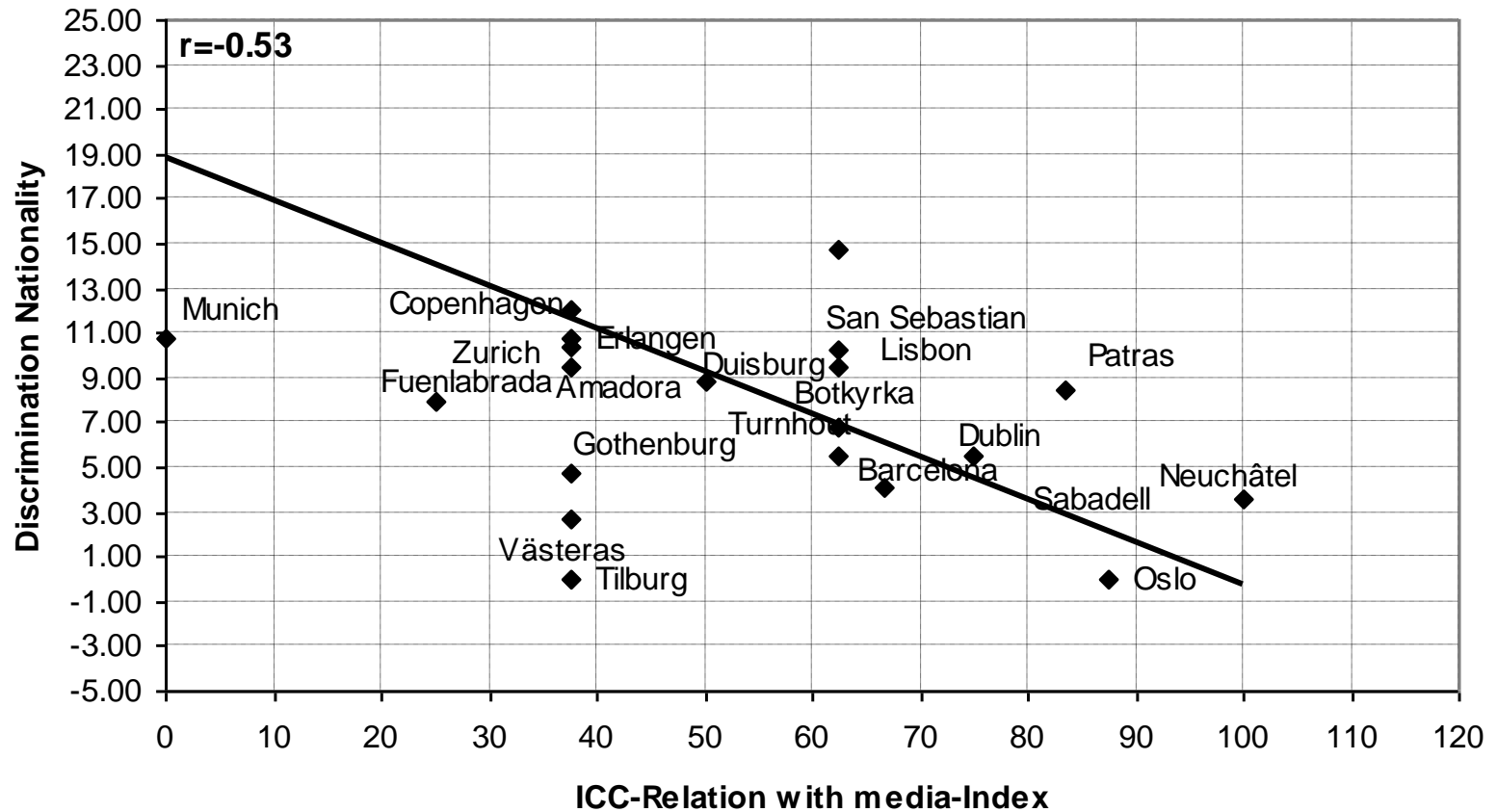

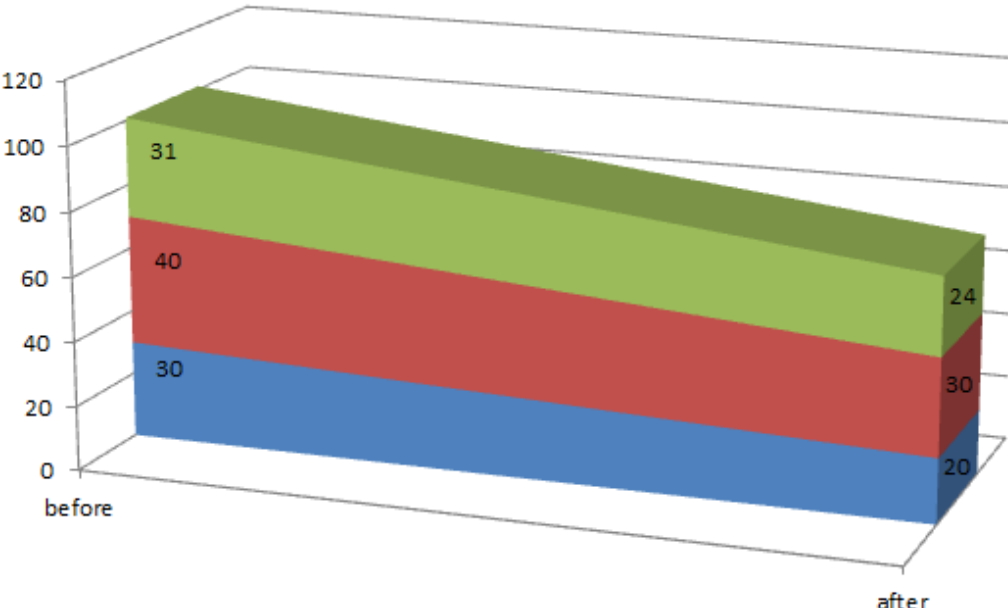
# Relation between the ICC-media and reported Discrimination



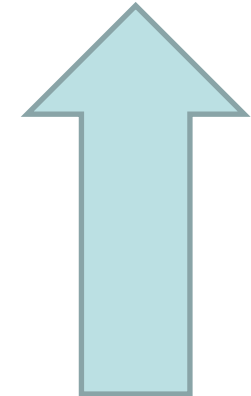
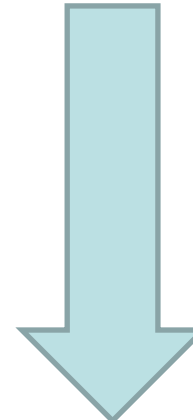
Note: Percentage of people who feel discriminated against.

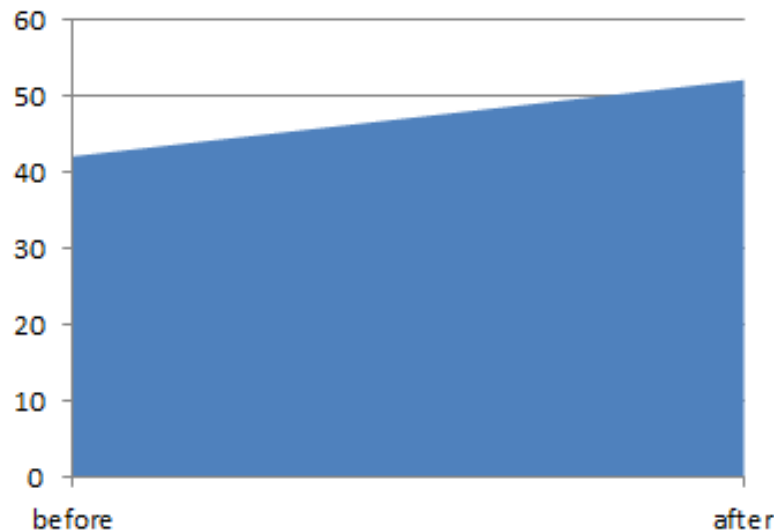

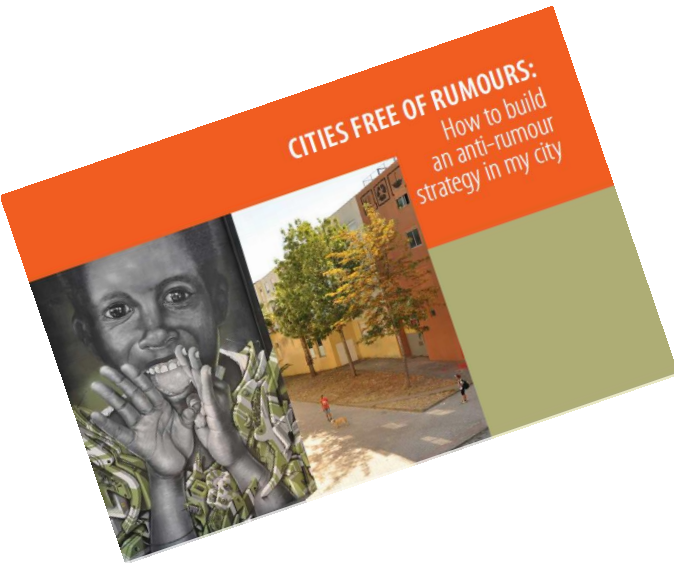

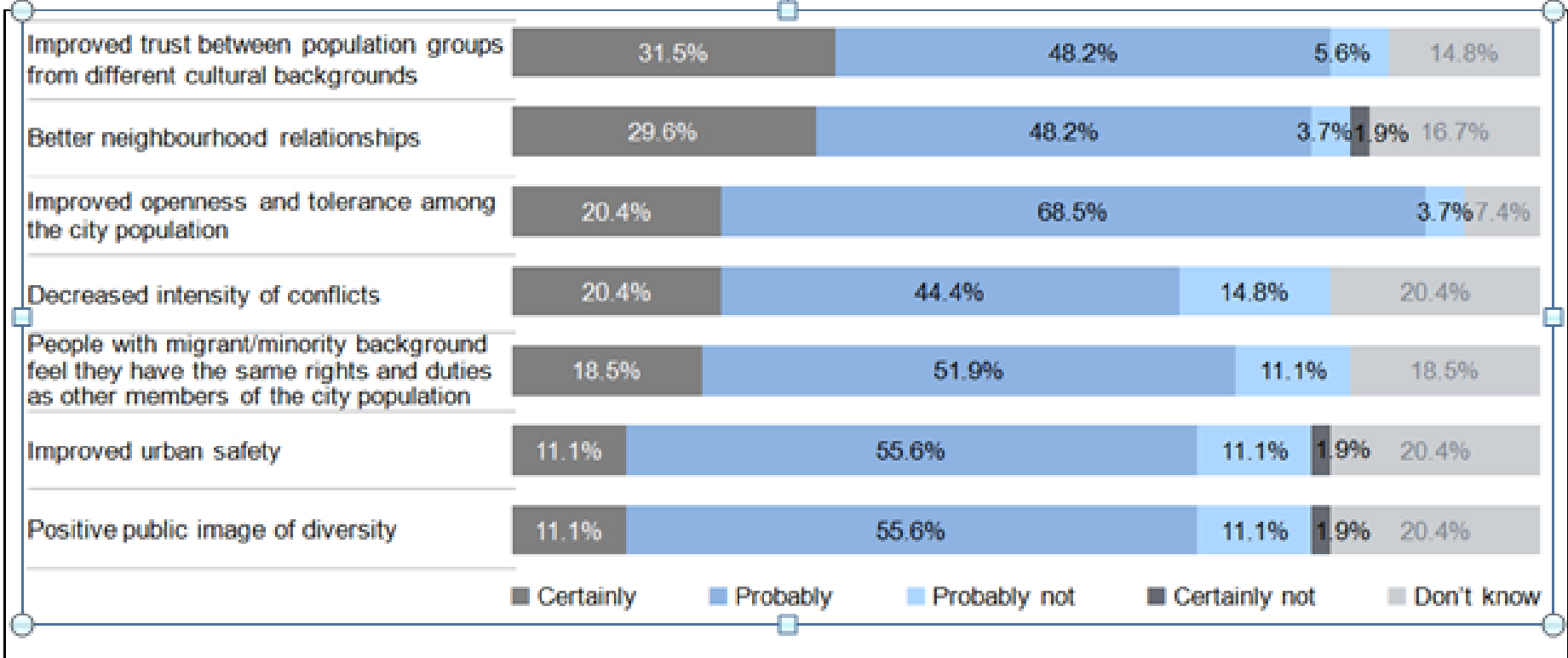
